Highlights

1. A competition of the grandest scale in the world judged by a discerning panel of experts.

This Tahitian dance competition boasts the largest number of solo participants in the world. This year the number of those who took part was the greatest in the history of the event, and over the two days, the hall was filled with excitement.

The judging was carried out by a panel of judges invited from Tahiti and each ranking was decided only after careful consideration. For the judging, by request of the judges, time for discussion was set aside in which they had heated debates.

The solo competition winners of each category received a trophy and certificate as well as a supplementary prize such as black pearl jewelry or a shell medal; second- and third-place winners were awarded a certificate and a supplementary prize. The grand prize winner received round-trip airfare to Tahiti.

The group competition winners received a trophy and certificate, and for the best performance, round-trip airfare to Tahiti was awarded.

2. The beautiful and heated competition by the select dancers, 'Ori Tahiti Dance Championship.

'Ori Tahiti Japan Championship is the most illustrious solo competition in Japan, limited to the soloists who were awarded from 1st to 3rd place in the past two years at the competition in the three cities put on by Tahiti Heiva in Japan.

In 2019 the fifth competition was held, and from amongst about 140 eligible participants, 104 competed.

They vied by performing mehura and otea, and this year's champion was Karen Homma.

3. Workshops, Mini Stage, and Photo Exhibition in the Lobby Was a Big Hit!

In the lobby were workshops on the use of ti leaves, a photo exhibition by Christian Durocher, and a mini stage. These were all crowd pleasers!





4. Shopping and Food Trucks.

The main feature of this event no doubt was the dancing, however, that was not the only thing to look forward to! There was also shopping at booths offering items from the homeland of Tahiti as well as from right here in Japan. Not only that, but the food trucks featuring all sorts of food and drink was well received.
